<u>O R D E R</u>

Before the court are the government's motion for a detention hearing and motion to continue the detention hearing. Title 18, United States Code, Section 3142(f)(1)(C) provides that, upon motion by the attorney for the government, the judicial officer shall conduct a detention hearing in a case that involves a drug offense punishable by ten years in prison. In this case, the defendant is charged, <u>inter alia</u>, with one count of conspiracy to distribute methamphetamine, punishable by up to life imprisonment.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f)(1)(C), the government's motions for a detention hearing are granted. It is further

ORDERED that the government's motions to continue the detention hearing are granted. It is further

ORDERED that a detention hearing is set for 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 27, 2009, in Courtroom 6E before the Honorable Sarah W. Hays.
