INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

Count One

(Conspiracy to Distribute and Possess with Intent to Distribute Cocaine)

From an unknown date, but at least as early as in or about February 2009, and continuing until on or about February 2, 2010, in Boone County, in the Western District of Missouri, and elsewhere, ADAM LOUIE CORONADO, ANTHONY CHRISTOPHER CORONADO, and KEVIN RAY HUNTER, defendants, did intentionally combine, conspire, confederate and agree with others, known and unknown to the Grand

Jury, to distribute and possess with the intent to distribute a controlled substance, that is, a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), and punishable under Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(B); all in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

Count Two

(Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine)

On or about February 2, 2010, in Boone County, in the Western District of Missouri, ADAM LOUIE CORONADO and ANTHONY CHRISTOPHER CORONADO, defendants, knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute 500 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1), and punishable under Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(b)(1)(B).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

(Allegation of Criminal Forfeiture)

The allegations of Count One of this Indictment are re-alleged and by this reference fully incorporated herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America pursuant to the provisions of Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.

As a result of the offense alleged in Count One, KEVIN RAY HUNTER, defendant, shall forfeit to the United States any and all

property, real and personal, constituting, or derived from, any proceeds the defendant obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of such violations, and any and all properties used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit, or to facilitate the commission of the violations alleged in Count One of this Indictment, including but not limited to:

United States currency in the amount of approximately \$17,980.00.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 846, 841(a)(1) and 853.
