MOTION OF DEFENDANT ANTHONY FRANCIS ALVAREZ FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OBJECTIONS TO PRELIMINARY PRESENTENCE REPORT

COMES NOW Defendant Anthony Alvarez, by and through his undersigned attorney, and moves the Court for a two-week extension of time until January 18, 2013, to file any objections to the preliminary Presentence Investigation Report.

IN SUPPORT of this Motion, Defendant states as follows:

- 1. Defendant was charged in two counts in an Indictment returned November 17, 2010, with engaging in a conspiracy to distribute controlled substances and with money laundering.
- 2. On October 16, 2012, defendant entered a guilty plea to a lesser included offense in Count 1, and a guilty plea to Count 2, as well as a forfeiture allegation, pursuant to a plea agreement. The defendant was remanded to custody pending sentencing.
- 2. The preliminary Report was prepared on December 18, 2012, and any objections are due no later than January 4, 2013.
- 3. Counsel believes there may be several objections to the Report, which require review of a substantial amount of discovery, as well as obtaining input from defendant, who is housed at

CCA-Leavenworth. A detailed analysis, meeting with defendant, and preparing the objections cannot be completed under the current deadline, and a two-week extension is requested.

WHEREFORE, Defendant prays that this Court grant an extension until January 18, 2013, in which defendant may file any objections to the preliminary Presentence Investigation Report.
