## ORDER

Before the court is defendant's motion for additional time to file pretrial motions. In support of his motion, defendant states as follows:

- 4. That there are 19 defendants in this matter with over 800 pages of discovery, thousands of telephone calls to review and several tapes of tapped calls to review. Additionally, many of these calls are in Spanish which require translation.
