MOTION TO INSPECT JURY RECORDS and to QUASH JURY PANEL

Comes the defendant, Frank M. Alvarez, pro se, and pursuant to Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, Rules 6(b)(1,2), and Rule 12; and, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Title 28 U.S.C. §§ 1867(a), and moves this Court to issue an Order to its Clerk ordering that defendant be provided with the grand jury records of the impaneled jury which indicted him. He also request that the Clerk be ordered to provide him with historical records of grand juries in pursuance with §1868 of Title 28 U.S.C., chapter 121.

SUGGESTIONS

On the date of November, 18,2010, a federal grand jury returned an indictment against this defendant in the Western District of Missouri, Western division.

- 2) Defendant Alvarez was notepresent copersonably, mor was the represented by counsel during the inpaneling of the jury; thus, he was deprived of his constitional right to chanllenge this inpanelment.
- 3) Alvarez has been indicted by an improperly inpaneled grand jury.

ARGUMENT

Alvarez asserts that he has both a constitutional and statutory right to challenge either a grand or petty jury inpaneled against him in criminal and civil proceedings. Id., U.S. cont. V, VI; F.r.Crim.P., R.6(b); 28 U.S.C. § 1867. As such, he therefor had the right to either be present himself , or to have a legal representor present on his behalf. This right has been deprived to him. Through indepent sources, defendant has been informedthat there has not been a juror mmember selected from Jackson County, Missouri, Kansas City, to serve as a federal grand juror in over three decades, in violation of the U.S. Constitutions fifth and Sixth Amendments' requirements that the accused "...shall enjoy the right to a speedy trial by an impartrial juryof the stateand district wherein the crime shall have been committed..." and that the jury be 'selected from a fair cross-section of the community.' the defendant further assrets that as a defendant in a federal criminal case, he has a constitutional and statutory righ to a grand jury and petit jury chosen without discrimination, which represents a fair cross-section of his community. Glasser v. U.S., 315 U.S.60,(1942); Smith v. Texas,311 U.S. 128 (1940); 28 U.S.C., §1861.

Alvarez points that he also exercise his right to challenge the grand jury which indicted him, Id.; F.R.Crim.P., R.6(b); and, therefore the records requested are need for thus reason. The provisions of the Jury selection and service Act of 1968 allows him an unqualified right to inspect the jury list at all reasonable times during the preparation of a motion to challenge compliance

with the jury selection procedure. Test v.U.S., 420 U.S., 420 U.S.28(1975)

28U.S.C. §1867(f)

Wherefore, defendant Alvarez prays this court to honorably grant his motoin requesting the herein needed material to properly prepare his defense in the criminal proceeding pending against him presently before this COURT.
