# **CLERK'S MINUTES**

## ATTORNEY APPOINTMENT HEARING

**REMARKS:** Parties present in person and with counsel to discuss the letter received from defendant on 12/8/11 (doc. no. 367). Counsel informs the Court that most of the issues set out in defendant's letter have been resolved since defendant has been moved to another facility. Defendant expressed continuing concerns, however, with coming into contact with co-defendants who are housed at the new facility. The Court discussed this matter with defendant, counsel, and the U.S. Marshals. Defendant complained that the visiting hours at the new facility make it difficult for his wife to visit. The Court directs Ty Cunningham or James Davies with the U.S. Marshals to contact the facility to make arrangements for defendant's family to visit. Finally, the Court discusses with defendant its concern with his anxiety issues and encourages defendant to request a doctor if his symptoms continue. If defendant is denied medical care, he should contact his attorney. Mr. O'Connor will continue his representation of defendant. Court adjourned.
