**REMARKS:** Parties present in person and with counsel ready to proceed on defendant's pro se motion for medical treatment/family visits (doc #421). Defense counsel informs the Court that the defendant does not require the assistance of the interpreter; Court confirming with the defendant, interpreter is excused for this and future hearings. Discussion held regarding defendant's letter. U.S. Deputy Marshal Steve Franovich addresses the Court regarding medical evaluation of the defendant.
