CLERK'S MINUTES

HEARING ON DEFENDANT'S MEDICAL ISSUES

REMARKS: Parties present in person and with counsel. The Court had set this hearing upon receipt of letter from defendant, filed 6/12/12. The letter indicates various medical complaints by defendant. The Govt presents evidence & calls witness USM Grant Goodman & offers exhibit #1, which is admitted over objection. Plaintiff's EX #1 is a CD of video surveillance at Lafayette & is played during the hearing. This video shows defendant working out. Evidence is presented that indicates doctors could find no medical problem for pain indicated by defendant. The Court directs defendant to seek medical attention by putting in request when needed and not to wait too long. If it is urgent, defendant should be seen by a doctor immediately. If a problem is not resolves, the Marshals are to be notified and should intercede. If problems remain unresolved, the Marshals should notify the Court. Defendant remanded to custody of U.S. Marshals.
