II. Pretrial Conference

Counsel are instructed to be prepared to discuss the following issues at the pretrial

conference:

- 1. Anticipated questions of admissibility of evidence, and
- 2. Any other questions of law on which the parties desire pretrial rulings.

The Agenda at the initial pretrial conference will include:

- 1. Facts or circumstances requiring a larger than normal jury panel (more than 45);
- 2. Pending motions;
- 3. Estimated trial time;
- 4. Discovery problems;
- 5. Possible stipulations (counsel should have proposed stipulations available for review and signature by the parties at the conference);
- 6. Number of exhibits to be offered at trial;
- 7. Number of witnesses to be called at trial; and
- 8. Change of plea or dismissal of charge.

Attorneys are instructed to be prepared to make such announcements as may be necessary in order that these cases may be tried or other disposition made. Each of these cases, unless given a special setting, is set for trial on the joint criminal jury trial docket, with all the available Judges of the Court sitting, commencing January 11, 2010.

III.

Continuances and Pleas

Regarding a change of plea, it is

ORDERED that counsel for a defendant who intends to change his plea from "not guilty" to "guilty" or "nolo contendere" shall immediately call the Courtroom Deputy of the assigned District Judge at the telephone numbers listed below so that a change of plea hearing can be set before the District Judge. **THE CHANGE OF PLEA SHALL BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE JANUARY 11, 2010, TRIAL DOCKET.** Counsel shall then immediately notify my chambers at 816-512-5745 of the date for the scheduled change

of plea.
