
To whom it may concern,

My name is Colleen Caw. I am a partner in a real estate appraisal company in St. Joseph, Mo. I am mother of Stephanie Caw, girlfriend of Charles Corbitt. Charles and my daughter Stephanie have been dating for approximately 4 years. Stephanie and Charles have been very close since they started dating and very close with me and my family. They lived about 4 blocks away from me. We talked almost daily, and if not they were at my house. Charles was always very good to me and my family members and friends. Always willing to help out with what he could on house, car repairs, etc. He would never let us pay him and if he did it would be very little. Charles means well and did get caught up in the wrong crowd at a younger age. After months of Charles and Stephanie dating, I seen a big change in him and doing his best to be responsible, but had a lot under his belt. Not only was he dealing with going to probation officer, trying to find a job in this economy, going to drug treatment, report to pre-trial investigator, but also coping and dealing with my daughter Stephanie, going through a major depression after she lost her job. He was there for her like no other person would of been. Here is the hard part, I signed the bond for Charles, why, because I trusted and believed in him. He told me and cried to me he would never do me wrong. Charles court dates were postponed numerous times. I think the more they were postponed, the more he got scared and the less he would talk to us about it. He got very distant to the people he cared about the most, because I think he knew he would be incarcerated soon. I think Charles is very remorseful for everything that has happened and knows how and can this has and does impact his life and everyone involved. I think, if he could live that part of his life over again, it would be much different. I think Charles needs help, but in guidance and counseling. It is my understanding the Charles has served approximately 10 months +/- for the crimes he did, and now they have enhanced the charges. According to the letter that I have read from the courts, Charles sentencing range is 235 to 293 months. It is my opinion this amount of imprisonment time will ruin Charles. Charles is a very caring and helpful person and would never hurt anyone. I plea for any leniency that the courts will give to Charles Corbitt.
