3. The attorney has struck the defendant with fear for his life by being unfaithful and rude to the defendant.

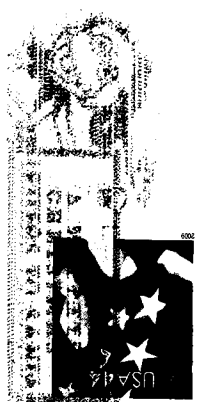
