REMARKS: Parties present in person: defendant C. Elder with counsel; Defts. Solomon and D. Johnson waived appearance and counsel Barnwart in person and counsel Ruden appeared by phone. Counsel Barnwart will have five days to file any briefing on the Joint Motion to Suppress Evidence (Document #115) and the Government will have 12 days after that has been filed to respond. The Court will then decide if a hearing needs to be held.

Discovery issues: Parties will need to file something by the 28th of October advising the Court and opposing counsel if the files from from the other ongoing investigation in Houston can be retrieved from Washington because of damages to the office due to Hurricane Ike.

The search warrant for obtaining the imaging on the hard drive has been done and information will be distributed to opposing counsel soon.

Counsel for the government advises the Court that a hearing on Document #117 (Motion to Suppress lay identification of handwriting of defendant ...) is not necessary;
