The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Government has obtained the Okose case reports from the Houston investigation from the electronic file room. Please be aware that when an investigator completes a report, the group secretary is supposed to send an electronic copy of the report to DEA Headquarters, who then enters the report in the electronic file room. Paper copies of field reports are no longer sent to DEA Headquarters unless specifically requested by a headquarters employee.

The Government is currently reviewing the investigative reports for discovery purposes. In particular, our review focuses on whether the reports contain a statement of a defendant in this case, *Brady* information as to this case, or *Giglio* information as to this case. The Government will produce any such materials by October 31, 2008.
