<u>ORDER</u>

On April 14, 2009, the Court held a hearing on the United States' Motion for Determinations Concerning the Representation of Defendants Solomon and Johnson. (Doc. # 190) Following the hearing, the government filed suggestions in reply to the defendants' suggestions in opposition to the motion. (Doc. # 218) In their reply suggestions, government counsel stated that the United States had offered defendant Johnson a plea agreement and that "[t]he terms of the agreement are such that attorney Bannwart cannot advise defendant Johnson concerning the merits of the agreement without creating an actual conflict of interest in his concurrent representation of defendants Solomon." (Doc. # 218 at 3) The government provided no further information concerning the terms of the proposed plea agreement, and counsel for defendants Johnson and Solomon did not respond to the claim that an actual conflict now exists. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that counsel for the government is directed to file the proposed plea agreement(s) in camera prior to the pretrial conference on June 30, 2008. It is further

ORDERED that counsel are directed to be prepared to address this issue at the June 30, 2009, pretrial conference.
