## DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO RECONSIDER CONTINUANCE AND TRANSFER

TO THE HONORABLE SARAH HAYS UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF MISSOURI, WESTERN DIVISION:

COMES NOW TROY R. SOLOMON, DEFENDANT, and respectfully requests reconsideration of the Court's Order denying both continuance and transfer of this case based on the following:

- 1. Trial is set to commence in this cause on June 21, 2010.
- The docket control order on the Houston case requires Mr. Solomon's appearance for the final pre-trial conference on June 21, 2010. The trial of that cause is set to begin on June 28, 2010. (Please see Exhibit One.)
- 3. Given the financial drain caused by simultaneously defending against two federal criminal conspiracy indictments, Mr. Solomon lacks the resources to pay for his travel to, lodging or minimal living expenses while in Kansas City. Further, Mr. Solomon cannot afford to pay for his witnesses to travel to Kansas City. Failure to continue this case and transfer the case to the Southern District of Texas (Houston Division) will result in the denial of Mr. Solomon's constitutional right to a fair trial by denying him the opportunity to present a defense.
