ORDER

On Tuesday, June 15, 2010, the Court held a pretrial teleconference with the parties in this matter. To clarify the matters discussed, the Court enters the following Order:

1. To the extent the parties wish to file amended witness and exhibit lists, those documents should be filed on or before **THURSDAY, JUNE 17, 2010**, by **NOON**.
2. Any stipulations shall be filed on or before **THURSDAY, JUNE 17, 2010**, by **NOON**.
3. Any response by defendants to the government's motion in limine (Doc. No. 319) shall be filed on or before **WEDNESDAY, JUNE 16, 2010**, by **NOON**.
4. Any response by defendants to the government's notice of intent to offer Rule 404(b) evidence (Doc. No. 269) shall be filed on or before **THURSDAY, JUNE 17, 2010**, by **NOON**.
5. Any response by any party to the Report and Recommendations as to Officer Kowal (Doc. No. 318) shall be filed on or before **THURSDAY, JUNE 17, 2010**, by **NOON**.
6. Each side will be granted **no more than 30 minutes** for their opening statement. Defendants must divide their time among themselves.
7. Trial days will commence at 8:15 a.m. each morning, and will end by 5:00 p.m. Lunch breaks will be 30 minutes, with additional short breaks in the morning and afternoon.
