- 3. Any response by defendants to the government's motion in limine (Doc. No. 319) shall be filed on or before **WEDNESDAY**, **JUNE 16**, **2010**, by **NOON**.
- 4. Any response by defendants to the government's notice of intent to offer Rule 404(b) evidence (Doc. No. 269) shall be filed on or before **THURSDAY**, **JUNE 17**, **2010**, by **NOON**.
- 5. Any response by any party to the Report and Recommendations as to Officer Kowal (Doc. No. 318) shall be filed on or before **THURSDAY**, **JUNE 17**, **2010**, by **NOON**.
- 6. Each side will be granted **no more than 30 minutes** for their opening statement. Defendants must divide their time among themselves.
- 7. Trial days will commence at 8:15 a.m. each morning, and will end by 5:00 p.m. Lunch breaks will be 30 minutes, with additional short breaks in the morning and afternoon.
