FINAL ORDER OF FORFEITURE

This matter is before the Court on the Motion of the United States for a Final Order of Forfeiture (Doc. No. 387).

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2008, the defendant Cynthia S. Martin entered into a Plea Agreement with the United States in which the defendant agreed that she had obtained \$660,742.00 in proceeds from the offenses alleged in Counts One and Two of the Indictment, for which the defendant has be convicted.

WHEREAS, the United States has filed a Motion for Entry of Final Order of Forfeiture which would consist of a personal money judgment against the defendant Cynthia S. Martin in the amount of \$660,742.00.

WHEREAS, Rule 32.2(c)(1) provides that “no ancillary proceeding is required to the extent that the forfeiture consists of a money judgment,”

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the defendant Cynthia S. Martin shall forfeit to the United States the sum of \$660,742.00 pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, § 853. Defendant Martin shall be jointly and severally liable with the other defendants in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States District Court shall retain jurisdiction in the case for the purpose of enforcing this Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 32.2(b)(4)(a), this Order of Forfeiture shall become final as to the defendant at the time of sentencing, and shall be made part of the sentence and included in the judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States may, at any time, move pursuant to Rule 32.2(e) to amend this Order of Forfeiture to substitute property having a value not to exceed the amount of the money judgments to satisfy the money judgment in whole or in part.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
