PURSUANT TO THE SPEEDY TRIAL ACT**

I, Cynthia Martin, do hereby acknowledge that I understand that pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161 (c)(1) because I have entered a not guilty plea to the indictment held herein, trial of my case must commence within 70 days from the date I first appeared before a judicial officer of the Court in which charges against me are pending, plus any period of delay authorized pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(1), (2), or (3). I further acknowledge that I understand that the failure of the Government to bring me to trial in the time required by 18 U.S.C. § 3161 may result in the dismissal of the indictment against me. I further acknowledge that I understand by filing this Acknowledgment and Waiver of my rights pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161, that I am waiving the obligation of the Government to bring me to trial in the time provided by 18 U.S.C. § 3161(c)(1); and that I am waiving my right to seek a dismissal of the charges against me for failure of the Government to bring me to trial within the time limits provided by 18 U.S.C. § 3161(c)(1). I am represented by counsel who has fully advised me of my rights under 18 U.S.C. § 3161.

WAIVER

I, Cynthia Martin, having a full and complete understanding of my rights pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161, with advice of my legal counsel, and with the full understanding that I am waiving those rights do freely and voluntarily waive my right to a speedy trial under the

provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 3161 and do hereby consent to a trial date beyond the requirements of 18 U.S.C. § 3161 as requested in my Motion filed herewith, if necessary.
