Parties appear for hearing. Defendant sworn. Court notes government's motion (#827) and parties' sentencing memos – motion granted. Counsel make statements and recommendations regarding sentence to be imposed. Defendant makes statement and allocution granted.

The Defendant is sentenced to Counts 1 & 13 . **INCARCERATION:** committed to custody of BOP for a total term of 200 Months. Count 1 – 140 months; Count 13 – 60 months consecutive to Count 1. **SUPERVISED RELEASE:** 5 Years on Count 13. **FINE:** fine waived. **SPECIAL ASSESSMENT:** \$200.00 due immediately. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED RELEASE OR PROBATION:** see J&C. The denial of federal benefits IS NOT ordered.

At defendant's request, he/she be allowed to participate in the 500-hour intensive residential drug abuse treatment program while incarcerated; and the Court recommends defendant serve the period of incarceration at the FCI in Arizona to maintain contact w/family.

All remaining counts are dismissed upon oral motion of government counsel.

Defendant remanded to custody of the USM.
