## ATTORNEY APPOINTMENT HEARING

**REMARKS:** Parties present in person and with counsel. At the October 13, 2011 suppression hearing, defendant informed the court that he wanted to represent himself. Because the hearing had been set for some time and government witnesses were present, the hearing was held, with Ms. Cardarella remaining as counsel; however, the defendant was given an opportunity to confer with his counsel after each direct examination of a government witness. The court was notified there had been a heated discussion during a recess between defendant and his counsel. The court proceeded to the conclusion of the hearing. The court asked the Deputy U.S. Marshal to file an incident report reflecting what was observed during that recess. A copy of that report is attached hereto as court's exhibit 1. Following that hearing, an ex parte motion was filed by Ms. Cardarella representing that a threat had been made and requesting a hearing.

After a brief statement by Ms. Cardarella, the court made a finding that Ms. Cardarella be relieved as counsel for the defendant and new counsel be appointed to represent the defendant in all further proceedings. An order will be forthcoming. Court adjourned.
