On June 9, 2010, I held a first appearance on this indictment. Title 18, United States Code, Section 3142(f)(2) provides that, on the judicial officer's own motion, a detention hearing shall be held in a case that involves a serious risk that the person will flee or a serious risk that the person will obstruct justice or threaten, injure or intimidate a prospective witness or juror (or an attempt of any of the above). In this case, defendant was under supervision at the time of the alleged offenses and has had a poor adjustment to supervision in the past. I find that these facts present a significant risk that defendant will flee to avoid further prosecution. Therefore, it is

ORDERED that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f)(2), a detention hearing is set for 9:30 a.m., Monday, June 14, 2010. It is further

ORDERED that defendant is remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal pending the hearing.
