## **BOND REVOCATION AND DETENTION ORDER**

On October 27, 2011, I received a Pretrial Services Violation Report concerning defendant Jason Carter. A bond violation hearing was held on November 2, 2011. Defendant did not admit to the conduct outlined in the violation report but surrendered on his bond.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that defendant be committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for detention pending trial. It is further

ORDERED that the Attorney General or his authorized representative ensure that the defendant is afforded reasonable opportunity for private consultation with his counsel. It is further

ORDERED that the defendant be confined in a corrections facility separate, to the extent practicable, from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal. It is further

ORDERED that, on order of a court in the Western District of Missouri, the person in charge of the corrections facility where defendant is confined deliver defendant to a United States Marshal for his appearance in connection with a court proceeding.
