I am writing you requesting information on the process of appealing my sentence. My attorney has not spoken to me about any of this, and I feel that due to other circumstances, as far as Ms. Nouri is concerned, it may be an issue of ineffectiveness assistance of council. This entire experience has been a lonely one for myself as a defendant, I also realize I may have been able to speak to you about these issues in court. The idea of upsetting your honor due to conflict was put in to a "not to do" category by my attorney and this caused me to be hush and wait until all was concluded to voice my grievances about my councilor's handling of my defense or lack there of I should say.

It has also come to my attention that I may have had other options within the plea agreement process that were not explained by my attorney, as the "motion" of or to apply mitigating circumstances to my plea agreement was submitted to the court 1 week prior to my sentencing date which by my view was improper and the motion itself contained nothing of substantial purpose to motivate your Honor to accept it or agree with it. Neither was the prosecutor's rebuttle supported by any substantial information, so in light of this as well as the overall lack of participation by my attorney, I am desiring an appeal of sentence imposed. Furthermore, I was not informed of any specific time limitation on this process. Your response in this matter would be most appreciated.
