CLERK'S MINUTES

HEARING RE: LETTER FROM DEFENDANT

REMARKS: Parties present in person and with counsel to discuss defendant's *pro se* letter expressing concern that her sentencing date has been set so far in the future. In its attempt to clear up an apparent misunderstanding, the Court explains to the defendant that, in fact, her sentencing date has NOT yet been scheduled. The Court asks counsel for the government if he has any insight into why a sentencing date has not yet been set for defendant. Government counsel offers that it may be due to the size of this multi-defendant case. The defendant states she is satisfied with this explanation. Court adjourned. Defendant remanded to custody of U.S. Marshal.
