Parties appear for hearing. Defendant sworn.

Parties argue defendant's objections. The Court sustains objection regarding 2-level gun enhancement resulting in a total offense level of 23 and guideline provisions of 60 to 71 months.

Counsel make statements regarding sentence to be imposed.

Defendant makes statement; defendant's parents make statements and allocution granted.

The Defendant is sentenced to Count 1.

INCARCERATION: defendant committed to custody of BOP for a total term of 64 Months.

SUPERVISED RELEASE: 4 years

FINE: Waived.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT: \$100.00 due immediately.

RESTITUTION: N/A

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED RELEASE OR PROBATION: see J&C.

The Court recommends to the Bureau of Prisons that: At defendant's request, he be allowed to participate in the 500-hour intensive residential drug abuse treatment program while incarcerated and further that the defendant serve the period of incarceration at the facility located in Yankton, South Dakota.

Additionally, the denial of federal benefits, as provided in 21 U.S.C. 862, is not ordered in this case.

Defendant's oral request to self-surrender is denied; defendant remanded to custody of the USM.
