Parties appear for hearing. Defendant sworn. There are no objections to the PSIR, and the Court adopts the guideline provisions w/o change. Court notes parties' sentencing memos. Counsel make statements/recommendations regarding sentence to be imposed. Defendant makes statement and allocution granted. Court finds advisory sentencing guidelines are greater than necessary over the objection of government counsel.

The Defendant is sentenced to Count 1 .

INCARCERATION: custody of BOP for a total term of 240 Months (20 years).

SUPERVISED RELEASE: 10 Years.

FINE: fine waived.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT: \$100.00 due immediately.

The denial of federal benefits IS Not ordered.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED RELEASE OR PROBATION: see J&C.

At defendant's request, he be allowed to participate in the 500-hour intensive residential drug abuse treatment program while incarcerated; and the Court recommends defendant serve the period of incarceration at a facility as close to the Kansas City area as possible to maintain family contact.

Counts 7, 15, and 16 are dismissed upon oral motion of government counsel.

Defendant remanded to custody of the USM.
