ORDER

Before the court are the government's motion for a detention hearing and motion to continue the hearing for three days. Title 18, United States Code, Section 3142(f)(1)(A) provides that, upon motion by the attorney for the government, the judicial officer shall conduct a detention hearing in a case that involves a crime of violence. In this case, defendant is charged with attempting to engage in conduct threatening to cause bodily injury to the victim with the intent to retaliate against the victim for information given by him to law enforcement, which is a crime of violence.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f)(1)(A), the government's motion for a detention hearing is granted. It is further

ORDERED that the government's motion to continue the hearing for three days is granted. It is further

ORDERED that a detention hearing is set for 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, 2009.
