CLERK'S MINUTES

COMPETENCY HEARING

REMARKS: Parties present in person and with counsel ready to proceed with defendant's Motion to Determine Competency and previous finding of incompetency. A forensic evaluation was conducted and report submitted to the court on March 21, 2012, by William S. Logan, M.D. Upon receipt by the parties of Dr. Logan's report, the government requested an opportunity to have the defendant examined by their medical personnel. A second forensic evaluation was conducted and report submitted to the court on April 21, 2012, by M. Anderson, Ph.D. Counsel stipulate to the evaluation reports. Based on the information contained in those reports the court will prepare a Report and Recommendation to the district judge finding the defendant incompetent to stand trial and directing that the defendant be transported to a designated institution for possible restoration of competency. Transcript ordered. Court adjourns. Defendant returned to custody.
